



**JACK IN THE BOX 2004**  
**Breakfast and After School Club**  
at  
**Whitehills Primary School**



Jack in the Box is an independently run breakfast and after school club that has been at Whitehills Primary School for fifteen years. It is managed by myself (Maureen Cross), with assistance from my husband, Graham Cross, and two other members of staff.

Both clubs are based in the studio which is situated near the school reception office.

Before joining either club, parents/carers must register their child(ren) by filling out a registration form. Once this is in place, parents/carers will be asked to fill out a booking form detailing the days they would like their children to attend. This is also the record of payment. Parents/carers and child(ren) are welcome to visit the club the week before they are due to start.

**BREAKFAST CLUB**

Breakfast club is open at 8.00am to 8.50am each morning, Monday to Friday during term time.

The children can choose an activity to do when they come in, while waiting for their breakfast to be served, and afterwards, return to the activity until it is time for school.

Breakfast consists of brioche, croissants, jam, yoghurts, fresh fruit, a variety of cereals, fresh milk and water to drink. This is freely chosen and encouraged.

At 8.50am the children gather up their belongings ready for school. The over 8s are sent to their classes and the under 8s are escorted to theirs.

The cost of breakfast club is £4.00 per child, per session.

**AFTER SCHOOL CLUB**

After school club is open from 3.15pm to 5.45pm, Monday to Friday during term time. Under 7s are collected or escorted from their classes and over 7s make their own way to the club. A register is taken as the children come into the club. The children can then decide what they would like to do next, i.e. have something to eat or play. Children can prepare their own food if they wish or ask a member of staff to do it for them. When everyone has eaten, then, the children can go outside to play.

The food available consists of ham or cheese sandwiches, sausage rolls, cereals, pizza, hot dogs, carrot sticks, cucumber, peppers, fresh or tinned fruit, fresh milk and water to drink. We aim to close the kitchen at 4.30pm, leaving out just fruit to eat and milk and water to drink. This is only meant to be a snack and should not be considered as tea.

All children are signed out on collection. All children **MUST** be collected by 5.40pm and have left the school site by 5.45pm at the latest.

The cost of after school club is £8.00 per child, per session.
